## **2011 St. Louis River Canoe Tour and Picnic Day of Event Information**

**How to Get There:** Munger Boat Landing, which is located at the end of Clyde Ave just off MN Hwy 23 in the Smithville neighborhood. Just before the east entrance to Morgan Park. Turn left on Clyde Ave. Follow to the boat landing. Call 218-348-8767 - if you need further last minute directions!)

- If you are not bringing a canoe or kayak, park in the upper lot and park two cars to a space. (lengthwise)
  
- If you are bringing a canoe or kayak, drive down to the lower parking lot or turn around, unload your boat, and then move up to the upper lot.

### **What to Bring:**

The essentials:

- Jacket, hat, sunscreen
- Life jacket - if you don't have one - one will be provided.
- Bottle of water, or container for water
- Beverage of choice for picnic (non-alcoholic)
- Bag chair or folding lawn chair (must in canoe).

The optionals:

- Seat cushion.
- Camera, binoculars for bird watching
- Rain gear

### **What to Expect:**

When you arrive, volunteers who are making canoe assignments for those without a canoe. Let them know how many adults and children are in your group and if anyone has canoe experience.

There will also be some kayaks for those who wish to use one. This boating landing is the perfect place to try a kayak for the first because it is sheltered from the main river current.

The tour is guided and everyone will leave the boat landing together as a group. The tour will explore areas of interest in this part of the

river, including Clough Island. (See map of proposed on website. Route may be changed due to wind and river condition.)

The picnic will be held on Clough Island. It will include hot dogs, brats, hamburgers, salads, bakes beans, bars, etc. (Veggie dogs will be provided.) Bring along your own beverage.

Participants may return to the boat landing on their own, if they wish. Motorboat assistance will be available.

This event will be held rain or shine! However, if conditions are not safe to be on the river, the canoe tour portion may be shortened or cancelled. Picnic may be moved to the boat landing.
